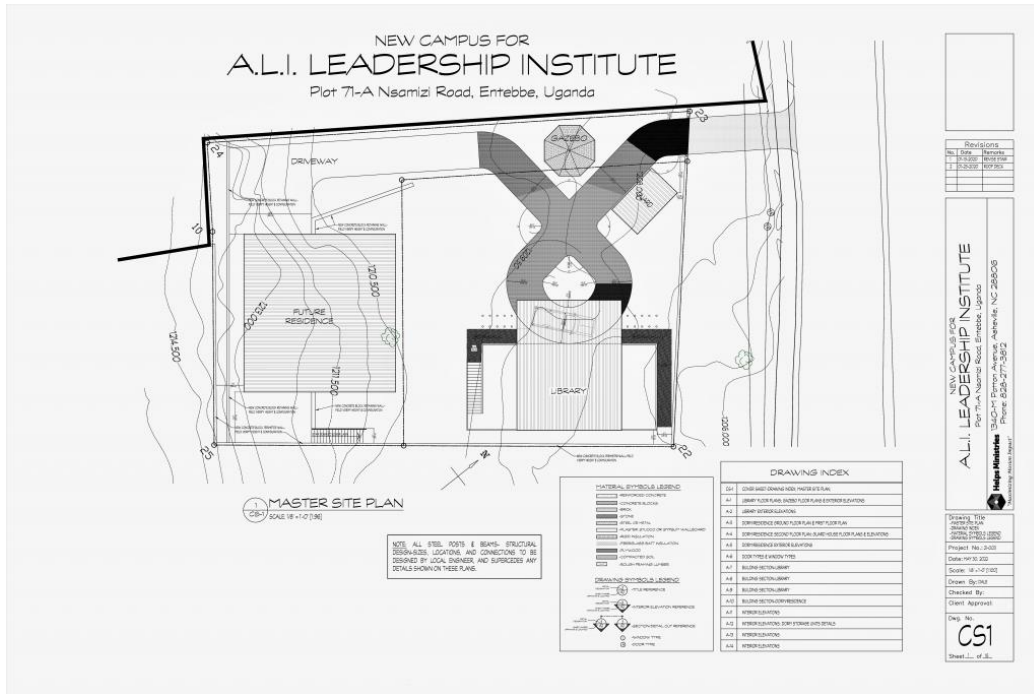
**As we finalize our model of leadership development for the continent
